EQUITA LYON 2024: TICKETS FOR THE 30TH EDITION OF THE SALON DU CHEVAL DE LYON ARE NOW ON SALE!

Equita Lyon, the Salon du Cheval de Lyon, will be celebrating its 30th anniversary from 30 October to 3 November 2024! The equestrian event, which has become a not-to-be-missed happening since it was created and played host to over 191,000 visitors last year, has gone from strength to strength, offering the international visitors a wide range of competitions and entertainment. And this anniversary edition has no shortage of highlights! For five days, Lyon will become the equestrian world capital and accommodate Europe's biggest stables. As for sport, Longines Equita Lyon, Concours Hippique International, will be hosting its traditional four FEI World Cup legs and with them the world's best combinations, including France's team bronze medallists, crowned at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. Ticket sales are now open!

GREAT SPORT ALWAYS ON THE AGENDA

Since the organisation of its first CSI (concours hippique international - international show jumping competition), in 2005, the event in Lyon has continued to support top-level sport. Longines Equita Lyon, Concours Hippique International is one of only two events in the world to offer four FEI World Cup legs: its first FEI Jumping and Dressage World Cup legs date back to 2009, followed by jumping for ponies in 2017, with the first edition of the FEI Jumping Ponies' Trophy, and lastly setting the ring in Lyon on fire, with the FEI Indoor Four-in-Hand Driving World Cup leg in 2018.

At the same time, the area devoted to Western riding disciplines has also experienced a meteoric rise. The Equita Lyon Western Horse Show, the leading Western riding event outside North America, will be hosting the NRHA European Derby for the 5th year running in 2024, a reining competition bringing together the best 5, 6,7 and 8-year-old horses in Lyon-Eurexpo's ring. Over two hundred horse and rider combinations are expected from all over Europe. On Saturday 2 November, the evening dedicated to the NRHA European Derby will once again showcase the only The Run For A Million qualifying event in Europe! Whether you're a Western riding fan or a novice looking for a thrill, the Western Area is a must-see at the Salon du Cheval de Lyon!
