

VETERINARY CERTIFICATE - MODEL

WARNING

In the context of the rules of the DDPP (Veterinary Services Branch), all participants have to provide a veterinary certificate from their veterinarian at his arrival to the event **or** a copy of the registration form of the horse in the TRACES System.

It is possible to provide one certificate for several horses (1 line NAME + ELECTRONIC TRANSPONDER NUMBER per horse)

Model below :

I, the undersigned, veterinary doctor registered with the Veterinarian National Order with the number and veterinarian following the stable (*address of the stable*), attests that the horse(s)

- HORSE NAME + ELECTRONIC TRANSPONDER NUMBER

is / are is free of clinical signs from category 1 infectious diseases for at least 30 days (equine infectious anaemia, West-Nile disease, equine swine fever).
